

How To Store My Rowing Machine



- 12 rowing machines
- 3 single file columns
- Line rowing fan on black tape
- Smaller areas, follow tape line as directed

Boats, Slings and Riggers




- Make sure all shells and boats are on the assigned rack
- All oars, slings, and step stools are re-racked and hung after use
 - Use wall racks for additional riggers and storage

Return Dock and Gooselines




- Dock for returning crews only
- Replace goose lines after use
- Do not remove red goose line
- Poles attach directly to dock




Launch Dock and Goose lines



- Dock for launching crews only
- Do not drop goose lines in water
 - Replace goose lines after use
 - Use purple holes for goose line
 - Do not remove red goose line



Weight Room Equipment and Procedures




Please Keep Weight Room Clean and Return All Weights and Equipment Please See Weight Room Rules and Policies Sheet for More Information

All equipment must be organized and stored in cabinets.



Keep the back hallway clear of all loose items.



Label all team equipment

Shells, Riggers, Rowing Machines, Oars, Electronics, Slings, Launches, Gas Cans Etc.









Items not permitted in Boat Bays

- Trailer racks/equipment
- Chuck wagon related equipment
- No overnight food or beverages
 - Flammable related materials
- Additional weightlifting equipment
 - Coolers
 - Tents
 - Cones
 - Tables
- Items Stored between Boat bays
